National Minimum Wages rates will increase for pay reference periods starting on or after 1st October 2009 as per the table below:

The government has also accepted a Low Pay Commission recommendation that the Main Rate should be extended to 21 year-olds. This will be implemented in October 2010.

Tips, gratuities, service charges and cover charges

Following a public consultation, the government has announced that the National Minimum Wage regulation will change from 1st October 2009 so that tips, gratuities, cover charges and

service charges will not count towards national minimum wage pay in any circumstances.
